## SENATE LEARNING AND TEACHING COMMITTEE

Academic Integrity Sub Committee Terms of Reference June 16, 2021

## 1. PURPOSE

The Senate Learning and Teaching Committee (SLTC) has, as part of its purpose, a mandate to oversee for broadly considering any emerging issues involving academic integrity, and to create and implement processes for handling matters where students are suspected of committing academic misconduct.

The purpose of the SLTC Academic Integrity SLTC in these responsibilities and to recommend policies and practices concerning academic integrity that may be applicable at both the institutional and Faculty level.

## 2. SUB-COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

- 2.1 Members, all of whom shall be approved by SLTC, shall comprise representatives from the following units and interest groups:
  - a) Chair of SLTC;
  - b) Faculty (3) with at least one being a current or past Academic Integrity Officer;
  - c) Students (3) with at least one being a member of the Dalhousie Student Advocacy Service;
  - d) Academic Quality Team;
  - e) International Centre;
  - f) English Language Program (Faculty of Open Learning and Career Development);
  - g) Accessibility Centre;
  - h) Centre for Learning and Teaching;
  - i) Agricultural Campus Student Success Centre;
  - j) Dalhousie Writing Centre;
  - k) Network Services;
  - I) Libraries;
  - m) Senate Discipline Committee; and
  - n) Manager, Discipline and Appeals, also serving as Secretariat support staff.

2.2 - Other relevant individuals and unit representatives may be invited to participate in the work of the Sub-Committee on an as-required basis.

2.3 The Chair shall be Chair of SLTC unless otherwise elected by members of the Sub-Committee.
