

Joint Anomalies Committee Report: 2016-2017

The Joint Anomalies Committee (JAC) meets each year to consider applications received by the deadline date for submissions from faculty members or their respective academic administrators. For 2017, this date was set as March 15, 2017. (D F K D S S O L F D Q W Z D V L Q I R U P H G R decision in their particular case on or before April 30, 2017.

A total of 27 applications were received all from individual faculty members as per the collective agreement (Article 31A), an amount of \$135,670 was allocated to the Anomalies Fund for 2016-2017.

Of the 27 applications, 23 were granted awards from the Anomalies Fund. The salaries of applicants were not deemed to be anomalous.

The total awarded from the Anomalies Fund for 2016-2017 was \$90,732.
